**RESOLUTION OF THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF BLOOMFIELD TERMINATING CONTRACT FOR PARKING
ENFORCEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the Township of Bloomfield (the "Authority"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, is authorized pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40:11A-1 *et seq.* to enter into contracts as deemed necessary for the efficient operation of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority engages non-Authority personnel to perform duties and responsibilities of parking enforcement officers, such as patrolling the parking facilities located in the Township of Bloomfield (the "Township"), enforcing parking regulations and other related duties and responsibilities (the "Services"); a dated as of September 1, 2011 nd

WHEREAS, Standard Parking Corporation, with offices located at 60 East 42nd Street, Suite 1425, New York, NY 10165, pursuant to a contract dated as of September 1, 2011 by and between Standard and the Authority (the "Contract"), performs the Services; and

WHEREAS, the Authority now desires to terminate the Contract in accordance with Section 901 thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Authority as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Authority hereby terminates the Contract in accordance with Section 901 thereof.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Authority.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.


